## Launch of major new bibliography of global education research: 09 November.

A significant milestone in the development of the global education research community will be recognised in the launch, on Monday 09<sup>th</sup> November, of the Academic Network on Global Education & Learning's (ANGEL) new bibliography of global education research and materials, the 'Global Education Digest 2020'.

The information resource, now including material published in English, French, German, Italian, Portuguese and Spanish, will be of interest to researchers, but also to policymakers and practitioners – and will be available on the ANGEL website from the launch date.

This new multilingual Digest aims to achieve several goals simultaneously:

- Provide a comprehensive picture of the relevant literature published in GE in the most widely spoken European languages
- Bring together data from several disconnected publishing spheres, facilitating comparison and encouraging reflection
- Directly illustrate the linguistic asymmetries and language barriers within academic publishing
- Providing a project and a resource that would galvanise and develop the ANGEL community

The launch event, from 9:30 – 10:30 (GMT), will feature contributions and comment from representatives of Global Education Network Europe, the European Commission's Development Education and Awareness Raising Programme, the contributors and project coordinators, as well as a discussion section. This project has been coordinated by Professor Massimiliano Tarozzi from the University of Bologna and the <u>Development Education Research Centre</u> (DERC), on behalf of <u>Global Education Network</u> <u>Europe</u> (GENE) in the framework of ANGEL activities.
