Who we are

The ANGEL project team respects your right to privacy and is committed to protect the confidentiality of your personal information. It has adapted reasonable administrative, physical and technical measures to prevent loss, misuse and alteration of the information under our control.

As a non-profit organisation, we are committed to maintaining the trust and confidence of our newsletter subscribers and visitors to our web site. In particular, we confirm that we will never sell, rent or trade email lists or any information we collect about our users with other companies and businesses. Please review this Privacy Policy for information on when and why we collect your personal information, how we use it, and how we keep it secure.

Cookies & Analytics

The ANGEL website site uses cookies — small text files that are placed on your machine to help the site provide a better user experience. In general, cookies are used to retain user preferences, store information for things like shopping carts, and provide anonymised tracking data to third party applications like Google Analytics.

As a rule, cookies will make your browsing experience better. However, you may prefer to disable cookies on this site and on others. The most effective way to do this is to disable cookies in your browser.

When someone visits the ANGEL website, we use a third party service, Google Analytics, to collect standard internet log information and details of visitor behaviour patterns. We do this to find out things such as the number of visitors to the various parts of the site. This information is only processed in a way which does not identify anyone. We do not make, and do not allow Google to make, any attempt to find out the identities of those visiting our website.

Mailing Lists

As part of your membership, you receive our e-newsletter. We collect personal information to allow us to direct these communications to you, on the topics you have identified that you want

to receive information on, as well as to contact you if we need to obtain or provide additional information; to check our records are right and to check every now and then that you're happy and satisfied. We don't rent or trade email lists with other organisations and businesses. We use a third-party provider, MailChimp, to deliver our newsletter. We gather statistics around email opening and clicks using industry standard technologies to help us monitor and improve our e-newsletter.
